Renewing Members :

Dues for the membership year beginning January 1, 2020, are due and payable on or before January 1, 2020, and are delinquent January 20, 2020. Any member submitting dues after January 20, 2020, for an existing member as of January 1, 2020, shall be assessed a late fee of \$100.00. If unpaid by February 14, 2020, the member will be subject to suspension. The membership of any member delinquent in payment of such dues on March 31, 2020, shall automatically terminate on April 1, 2020.

New Members:

New member dues are assessed from the date of licensure.

Members will be assessed a \$5 late fee if application and payment are not received by the 20th of the following month of licensure.

Special Assessments:

Above please note that the \$35.00 special assessment for the National Public Image Campaign has been broken out from NAR Dues. This fee is not prorated for new members.

Dues Deductibility:

RPAC Contributions are not deductible for income tax purposes. Contributions to RPAC are voluntary and will be used for political purposes. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal and the National Association of REALTORS®, any of its state associations or local boards will not favor or disfavor any member because of the amount contributed. 70% of each contribution is used by your state PAC to support state and local political candidates. Until your state PAC reaches its' National RPAC goal, 30% will be sent to National RPAC to support federal candidates and will be charged against your limits under 2 U.S.C. 441a. After the state PAC reaches its National RPAC goal it may elect to retain your entire contribution for use in supporting state and local candidates.

For **2021**, KAR has determined that **15%, or \$25.50** of your state dues of \$170, will be used for the purpose of lobbying political candidates. This is not income tax deductible.

For **2021**, with dues at \$150 per member, NAR computes **38%, or \$57**, to be **nondeductible for the member's income tax purposes** due to NAR lobbying efforts. Please note that the entire \$35 Public Awareness Campaign special assessment qualifies as fully
